Financial Report

A. Business Recruiting/Retention/Marketing/Communications

Maclean reported that the brochure/ resource guide for Downtown Merchants is in the final editing stage. The www.downtownludington.org web site is up and running and there have been 450 unique hits in 4 weeks.

Lyons gave an update on the events for the Winter Thaw-Out festival and the indoor shopping. A report of potential 2009 events and additions was given. The committee will be working on which events to proceed with and getting the word out.

C. Building and Grounds

Pontz reported that there was no report from the committee at this time. Mayor Henderson gave an update on new snow plowing procedures for the Downtown area that the DPW would be trying out.

The committee will be planning a meeting for early February to determine job duties and responsibilities for the new Downtown Staff person.

D. Friday Night Live/Christmas Parade

Payment reported that booking for Friday Night Live has already begun for 2009. The committee

will be meeting soon to outline themes and go through band applications.
Mayor Henderson gave an update on a New Years Eve ball drop idea he is working on for Downtown for 2009.
